
SOMEBODY SWALLOWED STANLEY

thought the other jellyfish.



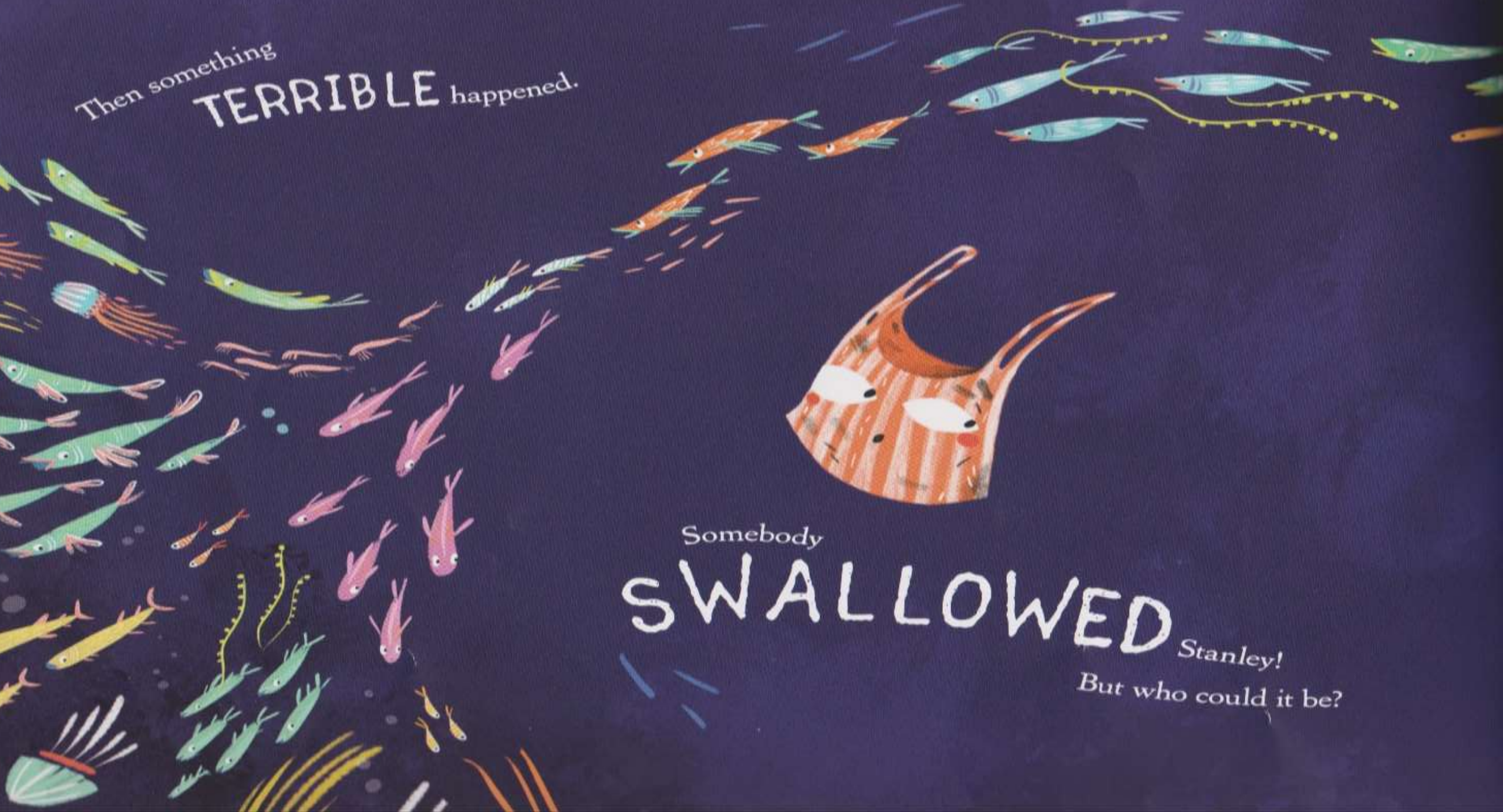
But his stripes were too straight and his tentacles too few.

TERRIBLE happened.




Somebody

Stanley!


But who could it be?

A **WHALE** had swallowed Stanley – but now he was out!

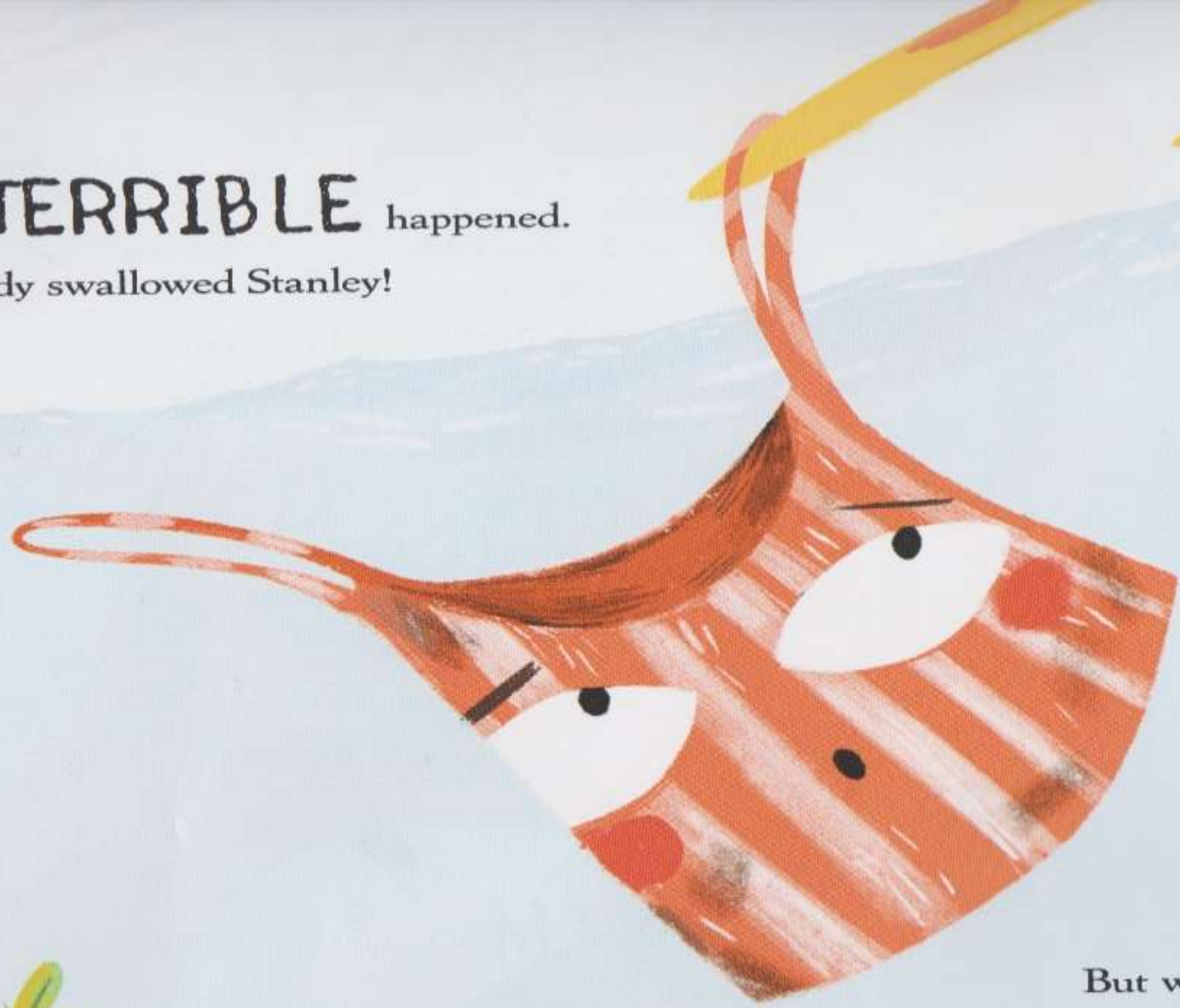


Stanley dropped — with a *splash* — back into the sea...

and **TORN.**

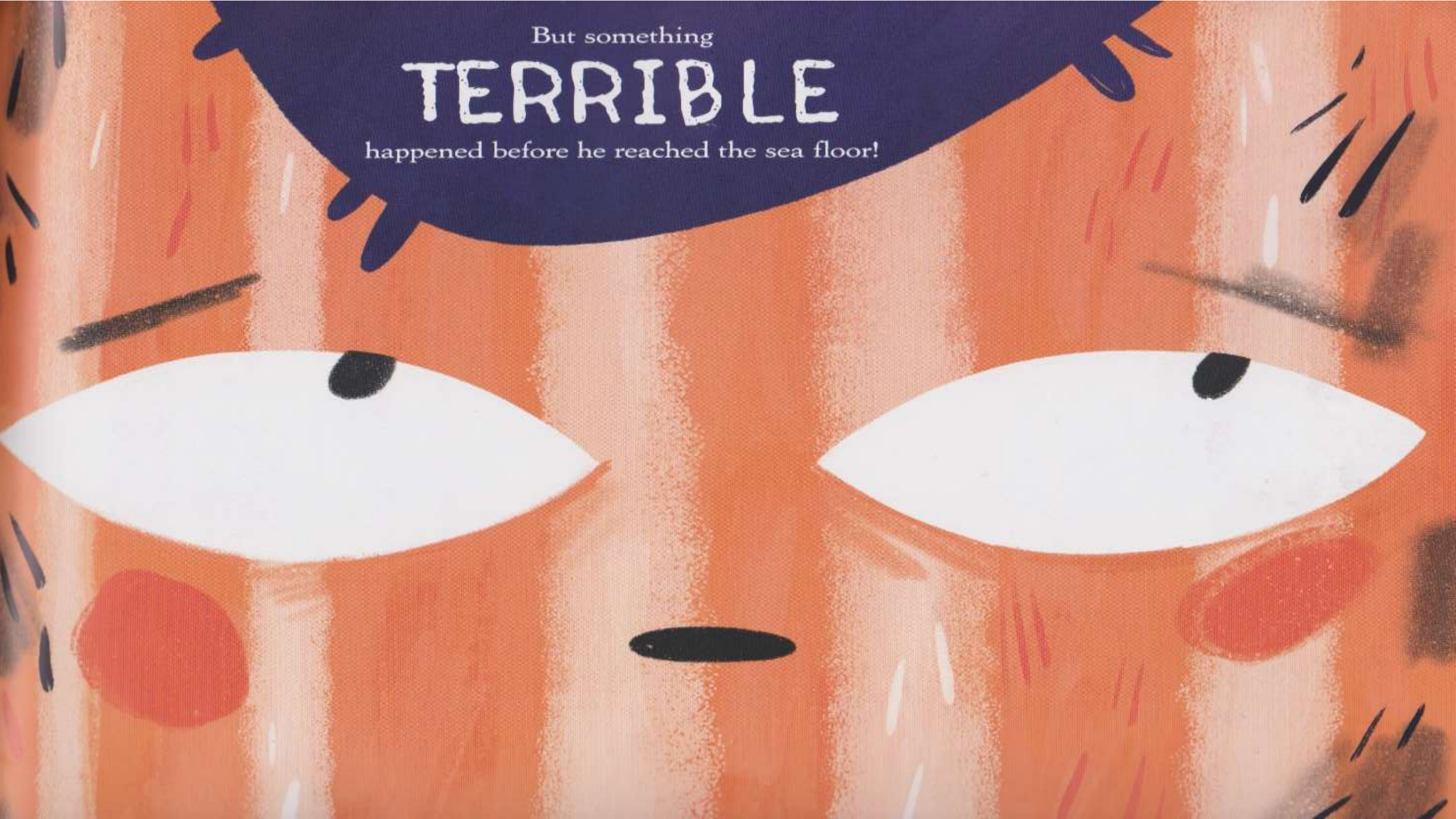
He sank,

happened before he reached the sea floor!

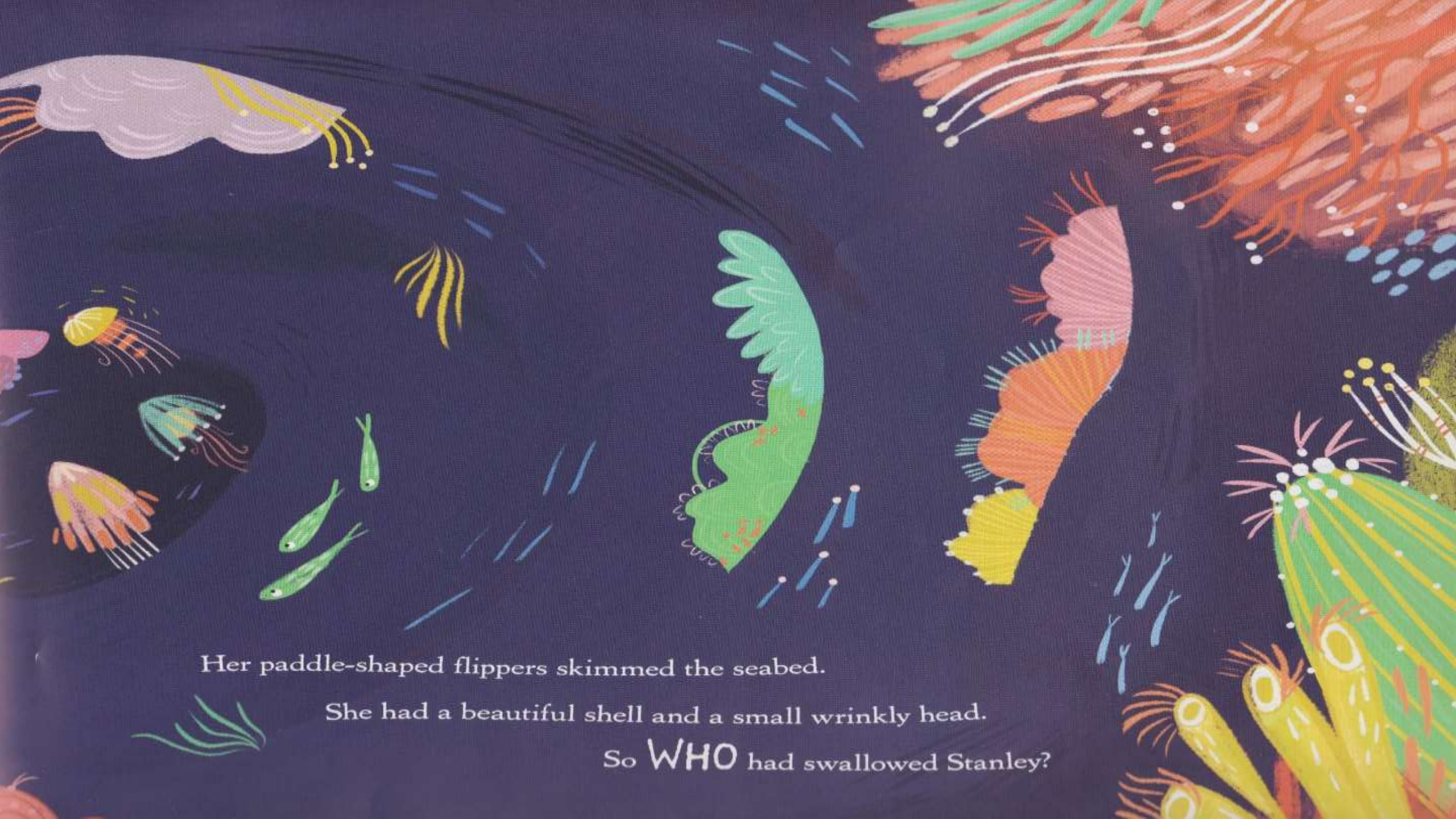




Somebody swallowed Stanley

Her paddle-shaped flippers skimmed the seabed.

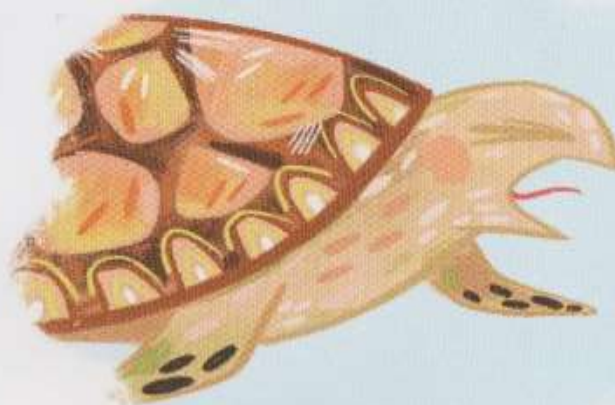
She had a beautiful shell and a small wrinkly head.
